

Fulbright Alumni Small Grants Program
Frequently Asked Questions

1. How many team members can be in one project?

Each proposal needs to have a **minimum of two** alumni team members. Once at least two alumni members are identified, the team can choose to hire as many additional alumni or non-alumni members as they see fit to support the project.

2. Is it mandatory for the coordinator to be a Fulbright alumna/us?

Yes, the project coordinator has to be a Fulbright alumna/ alumnus, and the remaining roles can be divided as seen fit by the team.

3. Can we submit a proposal with a topic that is not listed in your selected topics?

You can, however, good project proposals that fall within the range of selected topics have a higher chance of funding.

4. What is the maximum length of the project?

The projects should last for a maximum of 6 months from the award date.

5. What is the maximum amount of grant award?

KUSA will award projects in value up to \$6000.

No, the budget should be submitted only if your application is shortlisted for the second phase.
